




SUMMARY

The project has been created taking into consideration the growth and importance of the role of the Healthcare Clown professional performing artists, aimed at assisting and relieving the patients' anxiety and fear, especially in children and the elderly in healthcare institutions and social care services.

- 1. Designing, realizing, testing and validating an innovative training proposal aimed at defining the competences of those requested to work as Health Care Clowns in a sharing and transferable manner at European level;

MEETING & EVENTS

KICK-OFF MEETING

October 30th - 31st 2019, Flofence

The kick-off meeting which was held in Florence between October 30th and 31st 2019. During the meeting, the project was illustrated through a detailed working plan, intellectual targets and results, communication and spreading plan, and the plan for monitoring and evaluation. Time was also given to present the economic and financial rules for proper management of the Erasmus co-financing.

PRESS CONFERENCE

October 31st 2019, Florence

The press conference was held at the headquarters of the Tuscany Regional Council, in the presence of radio and television reporters, a proponent of "Ospedale Pediatrico Meyer di Firenze", several representatives of senior citizen residences, a proponent of H-CRIN+ European network of university researcher and of EFHCO. All the Project partners attending illustrated their own organization and the reasons of their involvement in the project.

The President of the Tuscany Regional Council Eugenio Giani reaffirmed the relevance of the project's aim to obtain the recognition and the European title of the new professional Healthcare Clown figure, as that of an expert attending in hospitals and the socio-medical structures which support children, the elderly, and adults with mental and physical disabilities.

STAFF TRAINING

December 2nd - 6th 2019, Paris


The Short-term joint staff training event was held in Paris from December 2nd till December 6th 2019. The French association Le Rire Médecin led the training. This association is the only one in Europe to have achieved the professional position of "Comédien(ne) - Clown en établissement de soins", corresponding to the 3rd level of the EQF System (European Qualifications Framework) and approved by the French Government.

During this 5-day formation period, each partner shared the reality of every single country, based on the general context illustrated by Rire Médicin. The fundamental points defined will be the object of the following Guide Lines (IO1) and methodological Framework (IO2).
